#### SERVICE TO FARMING COMMUNITY BY THE INSTITUTION

## a. Objectives

- i. To prepare and supply to farmers the organic humus in the name of Mycophose for improving the organic carbon content of soil.
- ii. To make water foot print analysis for indoor crops to ensure sustainable utilization of water for irrigation.
- iii. To promote entrepreneurship through the cultivation of mushroom spawn for public use.
- iv. To orient the farmers to adopt Integrated Farming System.

#### **b.** Context

The Soil Organic Carbon (SOC) content is required to range from 1 to 1.5 per cent. However, it has come down to 0.3 to 0.4 per cent in India. It is even below the national average in Madurai District. It has been declining rapidly due to raising atmospheric temperature, poor crop management, indiscriminate use of fertilizer, inappropriate soil tillage and so on. Thus, there is an urgent need to increase the organic carbon content of the soil, which is a key player for ensuring sustainable agriculture. Like the carbon footprint, the water footprint analysis for outdoor and indoor plants is also equally important to address the problems of water depletion and pollution.

#### c. Practice

- Mycophose humus with high level of organic carbon manufactured and distributed to farmers free of cost.
- Mushroom spawn prepared and supplied to small scale entrepreneurs at a subsidized rate
- Water and Carbon footprint analyses made for indoor crops.

#### d. Evidence of Success

It is learnt from the beneficiary farmers that the organic carbon contents of their fields have improved, evident in increasing productivity.

#### e. Challenge

To make the farmers understand the technicalities involved in the farming processes poses a challenge. However, the Institution overcomes it through utilization of expertise available in the field.
