# **Objectives**

Documents related to syllabus, course schedules, internal assessments, assignments, seminars, teaching methodology, attendance of the students, teaching profile, teachers' other academic and professional, achievements, covering of syllabus, question patterns, result review, ward system, feedback system, remedial measures, evaluation process, etc. are judiously examinedby the committee to identify the grey areas to be addressed to enhance quality culture of the institution.
