



Profile of the College

Thiru. L. Narayanan Chettiar, a renowned philanthropist founded Saraswathi Narayanan College at Perungudi near Madurai Airport in the year 1966. The college is a prestigious academic powerhouse catering to the educational needs of students hailing from economically weaker and socially oppressed section of our society. It imparts education of the highest quality to students irrespective of caste, creed and religion. The guiding principles of our college are duty, devotion and distinction. The institution has proved an innovative leader and a catalyst in the best educational, cultural and economic interests of students. It is committed to make the students morally upright, intellectually resourceful, socially advantaged and globally competent. It is devoted to teaching, research and extension activities with equal importance.

The college set off its academic journey with Pre-University Courses in the year 1966-67. The Institution started offening UG programmes from the academic year 1968-69. It was upgraded as Post-Graduate Institution in 1979-80 and as Research Institution in 1984-85. The co-educational system was introduced for M.Phil. programmes in the academic year 2001-02 and for PG programmes in the year 2002-03 with the noble objective of promoting higher education among girls in rural areas. Girls have been enrolled in UG programmes also since the academic year 2010-11.

The green campus of 66 acres has a built-up area of 1,70,059 sq.ft. A new library housed at Silver Jubilee building was built at the cost of Rs. 25,00,000/- and it was inaugurated by His Excellency Dr. M. Chenna Reddy, the then Governor of Tamilnadu on 04,04,1994. The library was dedicated to the memory of Achi. The major donor of this building was Tmt. Saraswathi Narayanan, the better half of the Founder President Thiru. L. Narayanan Chettar. Sri. Vidhya. Ganapathi. Temple was built and consecrated on 27,08,2015.

The Departments of Botany, Mathematics, Commerce, English, Economics and Chemistry have been upgraded as university recognized research centres to carryout M. Phil. and Ph.D. research programmes in the college. NAAC accredited the college with grade B+ in the year 2005. UGC accorded the Status of Autonomy to our institution in the year 2007. NAAC re-accredited the college with grade B (CGPA of 2.78) in the year 2016. UGC extended the Status of Autonomy to the institution for another period of five years from the academic year 2016-17.

College Rules and Regulations

a) Admission and withdrawal

- Admission will be made as per the rules and regulations of the Government of Tamilnadu,
- Students withdrawing from the College during the course of the year shall pay all the fees due up to the date of withdrawal as well as the special fees for the on going semester.
- 3. No fee will be charged for the issue of Transfer or Conduct Certificate at the end of any course of study if the student applies for the same within 15 days of the following semester. A search fee at the rate of Rs.10 per year shall be collected for late application for the certificates. A search fee of Rs.10 (Rupees Ten) will be collected from students for issuing the certificates when applied for after two years of their leaving the College. Students are strictly advised to collect their transfer certificates and conduct certificates at the end of the course. A fee of Rs. 50 will be charged for issuing any certificate other than T.C. and C.C.

b) Payment of Fees

 The fees shall be paid lump sum not later than the fifth working day of each Semester.

- 2. Payment with Fine: If a student fails to pay his fees on time, a fine at the rate of Re 1/- per day shall be levied. If the fee is not paid within the month of the semester, the student shall stand off from the roll. If re-admitted, he/she shall, in addition to the fees and fines dues from him, pay re-admission fee of Rs. 10/-
- If a student leaves the college during the semester, he/she shall have no right to claim remission of the semester fees paid.

c) Students Services

The following are the facilities to foster better services to the students:

- Counseling Centre
- ii) Vocation Guidance Centre
- iii) World University Service
- The Students Service Director assisted by three other members of the staff counsels the students in their personal and educational shortfalls.
- The Director of the Vocational Guidance Centre along with the Librarian give authentic information about vocational opportunities to the students in their respective disciplines. Training to the students to appear successfully for competitive examinations and interviews is given by this centre.
- World University Service is a service organisation comprising students, teachers and administrators sponsored by the various universities.

The Vice -Principal is the director for the WUS wing of the college. He is assisted by the N.S.S. and N.C.C. Officers. The wing discharges its duties in collaboration with the Dept. of Youth Welfare, Madurai Kamaraj University.

d) Proctorial System

Each student will be the ward of a teaching staff who will be his/her Proctor.

Duties and Responsibilities of the Proctors

- A Proctor shall submit to the Principal at the beginning of the academic year, individual reports on his/her wards in the prescribed forms.
- He/she shall consistently watch the progress, attendance and conduct of his/her wards on and off the campus and submit terminal reports in the prescribed form.
- He/she shall hold periodical interaction/audience/ meeting with his/her wards.
- He/she shall scrurtinize the leave application of his/her ward and make his/her recommendations before the student submits the leave application in the office.

e) Attendance and Leave of Absence:

- It shall be the duty of each student to attend college regularly and punctually on all working days and go through the course of instructions satisfactorily.
- A student who has to be absent himself /herself shall submit an application in the prescribed form to his/her Proctor. A student residing in the College Hostel shall submit his/her application to the Proctor concerned with the remarks of the Warden.

The application for leave shall be submitted in advance to the Proctor or the Principal to get the leave granted. In case of sudden illness, the application with medical certificate shall be submitted at the office. All leave applications with the remarks of the Proctor shall be submitted to the Principal for approval.

In each case, the reasons for absence should be fully explained. The Principal reserves the right to call for a Medical Certificate and to decide each case on merit.

In all other cases, leave applications should be submitted before 1.40 p.m. on the first day of attendance after the period of absence.

- The granting of leave is at the Principal's discretion. Non-compliance with the rules will entail automatic refusal of leave unless the student explains to the satisfaction of the Proctor. His/her failure to comply with the rules and habitual non-compliance will entail imposition of fine or removal of the student from the roll of the college.
- 4. If a student is absent unauthorized for a continuous period of ten working days, he/she will be dropped from the roll. If the cause of leave fails to stand to the satisfaction of the Proctor, leave application will not be considered. Unless the student proves his/ her absence unavoidable, he/she will not be considered for readmission.
- A working day comprises five periods of one hour each. Attendance shall be taken every period.

Reporting to class late without genuine cause shall not be entertained. A student shall request the teacher concerned for leave of absence for a period in an invitable circumstance.

- A fine of one rupee for a day and 50 paise for a period of a class will be levied for absence without leave.
- The attendance certificate will not be issued to a student unless (i) the Principal is satisfied that the student's progress and conduct and (ii) he / she has attended three-fourth of the total number of working

days in the academic year.

Attendance Certificate will be withheld for the students who have not attended at least 75% of the classes in the academic year.

All the scholarship / Fee concession holders should earn at least 90% of attendance, failing which the entire Scholarship / Fee concession amount has to be surrendered to the Social Welfare Department.

- f) Conduct and Behaviour
- Every student shall wear clean and suitable clothing.
- Every student shall demonstrate the gesture of respect to the staff.

- When a member of the staff enters the class room, the students shall rise and remain standing till they are desired to sit.
- No student shall leave the class room or laboratory without the permission of the teacher concerned.
- Students are strictly prohibited from loitering on the verandahs of the College during the class hours
- Students who have no class to attend in any period shall go to Library No students on any account shall disturb the classes at work.
- When attending meetings and functions in the college, students should be decently dressed. They should be politic and courteous to all, respectful to seniors, (ready to oblige) and should good order and decent behaviours.
- In regard to matters not specified above, students shall aim at conducting themselves in a manner thoroughly worthy of the college, and in harmony with the best traditions of Indian life and culture.
- g) Disciplinary Regulations
- Unfair practices of any kind on the campus are punishable offences.
- No student shall take part in or organise any demonstration or strike.
- Students are strictly forbidden to take part in political agitation directed against the authority of the Government.
- The use of mobile phones by the students on the college campus is strictly prohibited and the violation of this will attract punishment.

- The Principal or other constituted authorities of the college or Hostel may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the students' conduct outside the College or Hostel Precincts so far as such rules seen necessary.
- 6. The Principal or other constituted authorities of the College or Hostel shall have the power to execute penalties like fine, withholding attendance certificates, suspension or expulsion from the College, cancellation of scholarships and fee concessions.

h) Library and Reading Room

The College Library consists of two sections viz., the General Library with the reading room and the Departmental Library

Rules

- The Library and the reading room are open to all the members of the college.
- 2. Students are entitled to keep the borrowed books for two weeks from the date of issue. The books after use shall be returned to the Library on the date marked on the date slip. But they may be retained by the same user, if they are not in the meantime applied for. When reissued, the books may be retained for not more than three such renewals. The books should be produced before the Librarian for every renewal.
- The Librarian may recall the book at any time even if the normal period of lending has not expired.
- A student failing to return a book on the due date shall have to pay fine as per the rules.

- A student who has to pay a fine or any other charge to the library shall not be allowed to borrow books.
- Absence from college shall not ordinarily be admitted as an excuse for delay in returning the books.
- 7. Reference books will not be lent.
- Students are expected to use all books with care. If a book is lost or damaged, the defaulter shall have to replace the book or to pay the current price of the book.
- Practice of soiling, marking, underlining, clipping, or annotating in the books is forbidden and the violation of this will attract disciplinary action.
- The student who has used a book shall be held responsible for any damage of the book which he did not expose at the time of his taking it.
- A student who wishes to borrow a book shall submit slips to the Librarian at the allotted time.
- 12. The Library is open on all working days from 8.00 a.m. to 2.15 p.m.
- Students shall leave their own books at the entrance of the Library before they enter the Library.
- Reference Books can be used with the permission of the Librarian and the books used should not be reshelved by the users themselves.

- No book from the reference section can be borrowed to be used off the library.
- 16. Strict silence should be observed and decorum should be maintained in the library. It is in the power of the Librarian to refuse the issue of books or recommend disciplinary action against the student for breach of the code of conduct of the library.
- All complaints and suggestions should in the first instance be made to the Librarian who will, when necessary, refer them to the Principal.
- Students should return all the library books at the end
 of their course or at the time of their leaving the college
 whichever is earlier. All dues should be paid.
- 19. Members of the teaching staff are entitled to borrow 15 books from the Library for their use. All the books borrowed in a semester should be returned to the Library at the end of the Semester and may be re borrowed on need.
- 20. Members of the non-teaching Staff can borrow the books they need. Books may be recalled at any time by the Principal, if required.
- Each post graduate department has its own departmental library for the exclusive use of the P.G. students.

Co-Curricular Activities

There are a number of schemes to involve the students in co-curricular activities. They provide opportunities for the students to have an overall development of physical, social and intellectual abilities.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

There are three units in our college. The scheme is open to the students of I and II year degree classes. The scheme provides ample opportunities to students to have a deep sense of involvement in nation-building. It inculcates a spirit of national consciousness and willingness to serve the country. The volunteers of the Scheme have to serve for 220 hours. They shall participate in rural reconstruction camps conducted periodically.

National Cadet Corps (NCC)

A company of N.C.C functions in our college. Students of under graduate classes are enrolled in NCC which has 'unity and discipline' as its motto. It provides an opportunity to the students to develop the spirit of sportsmanship, a sense of service, leadership qualities and an amiable character. N.C.C attempts to create a force of disciplined and trained man power which in national emergency could be of great assistance to the country. Eligible cadets can attend Annual Training Camps. Army Attachment Camps, All India Leadership Camp, Republic day parade, etc., They can appear for B and C certificate examinations.

College Hostel

Principal - Warden

 The hostel shall be under the general control of the Principal. The Principal will be assisted by a warden who is a member of the Teaching staff of the College.

- The Principal may appoint in consultation with the warden Resident Proctors who will carry out such duties as may be prescribed by the Principal.
- Student representatives shall be selected if necessary from among the inmates of the hostel to assist the Warden in the discharge of his duties.
- The hostel committee consists of the Principal, the Warden, the Student Secretary, the Mess Representative and any other member co-opted by the Principal.
- 5. No guest will be allowed to stay in the hostel.
- Members of the teaching staff may be permitted by the Principal to stay or board in the hostel.
- 7. Admission to the hostel will be made by the Principal and the Warden. Application for admission must be made to the Warden in the prescribed form available in the hostel office on payment of Rs. 25. Admission is not restricted by any consideration of caste or creed. However, the admission to the hostel is at the discretion of the Principal.
- 8. The following charges shall be paid by every hostel student at the time of admission:

i)RoomRent

- Rs. 7,000 per annum

ii) Establishment

Charge

-Rs. 8,000 per annum

Room rent and establishment charge should be paid at the beginning of every academic year.

The mess dues must be paid promptly failing which, the inmates shall not be allowed to stay in the hostel.

- No student can withdraw from the hostel before the completion of the academic year without the permission of the Warden.
- The hostel authorities are not responsible for any loss of money or valuable articles. The inmates are advised to open savings bank account in the Post Office located on the college campus.

Boarding and Lodging

- No student shall leave the hostel without proper permission of the Warden.
- 2. Only vegetarian food will be served in the Hostel.
- The hostel committee reserves the right to prescribe the menu.
- 4. The boarding charges for each member per month shall be worked out in the first week of the following month. The mess bill for each month will be put up on the notice board and every boarder shall pay his dues on or before the 15th of the month. Fine will be levied for the delay in payment. (No meal shall be served to the defaulters)
- Food shall not be served after the time specified.

- Boarders shall on no account be served food in their rooms in normal circumstances.
- Reduction of one day will be given if the period of absence in the hostel exceeds five days. Full mess reduction will be given if the absence exceeds ten days. Application for reduction must be made to the Warden in advance.
- Boarders are free to attend any local cinema on Saturday.
- Students must keep their rooms locked on leaving for classes.

Medical Aid

The medical officer of the College visits the hostel regularly to examine the cases of sickness for suitable medical attention. All cases of illness should be immediately reported to the Warden.

Disciplinary Rules

- The students in the hostel shall have study schedule for one hour from 8.30 p.m. to 9.30 p.m.
- Every student should remain in his room and study his subjects during the study hours. Dishonouring the study schedule by a student shall attract serious action.
- No student shall be absent himself from the hostel after 8.00 p.m. without the prior permission of the Warden.

All students shall keep their room for inspection by the Principal / Warden failing which a penalty of one rupee will be levied for each default. If this kind of absence is noticed more than two times, the punishment will be very severe.

- Students of the hostel shall observe complete silence during the study hours.
- No student shall stay in the hostel by abstaining from the classes without permission of the Warden.
- No student shall halt at the hostel during the vacation.
- No boarder except student Representative is allowed to enter the kitchen.
- The inmates of the hostel shall on no account entertain any hard terms with the cooks and other mess workers.
 Complaints and suggestions, if any, may be made to the Warden.
- Boarders shall not convene meeting of any kind in the hostel without the formal permission of the warden.
 Even if permitted, the meeting must be over by 8-00 p.m. They shall also refrain themselves from circulating any notice or petition without the prior permission of the warden.
- 10. Any damage to the hostel property such as chairs, tables, trays, electric fittings etc., shall bind the boarder at default to pay for the loss and if the offender is not traceable, damage shall be compensated by all the boarders themselves in the room collectively.

- Misconduct of any kind or breach of any of the Hostel Rules will render the offender liable to fine and suspension or expulsion.
- The inmates should not tamper with the electrical installations in their rooms, and the use of extra light, electric heater or fan is strictly forbidden.
- The inmates should not participate in or subscribe to political activities and agitation on the Hostel premises. The warden shall expel the student who violates this rule.

The Principal shall be the ex-offcio president of all the above Associations and he will be the final authority on all matters pertaining to the Associations. The Vice Presidents of the Associations shall be nominated by him from among the members of the teaching staff.

Meeting shall be held only with the prior approval of the Principal or any Vice President deputed by him for this purpose.

No expenditure shall be incurred except on the permission of the Principal. The current fund of the Association shall be kept in such a status as the Principal may direct. All expenditures shall be incurred only on sanction by the Principal.

(Athletic Association)

- The Association shall consist of all members the teaching staff and students on the roll of the College.
- The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Committee consisting of
 - i) The Principal who shall be the President.
 - ii) The Physical Director who shall be the Secretary and Treasurer.
 - iii) One member of the teaching staff and
 - iv) Two student representatives.
- The physical Director shall maintain a stock list and an issue book of all materials. The accounts of the Association shall be maintained by the college office.

- Every student member shall pay each year Sports and Games Fee prescribed by the Principal.
- 5. The Physical Director with the help of the respective Captains appointed by the Principal shall be responsible for the proper conduct of sports and games.
- Normally indoor games will be provided for students between 3p.m. and 6p.m. on working days.
- 7. Students are advised to ask for articles of indoor games from outside the store room which they should not enter for any reason whatsoever. They should borrow the play articles and return them after use making due entry in the relevant register.
- Only students who have regularly participated in the inter-collegiate and open tournaments representing the College shall apply for games certificates at the end of the course.

Examination Rules and Regulations

Scheme of Examinations

In the semester, the evaluation of the progress of students is done by the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) tests and the Semester examinations. Students shall have to appear for two internal assessment tests. No retest in any subject will be conducted under normal circumstances.

The internal assessment carries totally 25 marks viz 15 marks for the test, taking the average of two test scores, 5 marks for assignment and 5 marks for seminar / interaction in the class room.

II) Semester Examination: Rules and Regulations

- Students without hall ticket and identity card shall not be permitted for examination.
- Possession of undesirable materials in any form is prohibited inside the examination hall.
- Students indulging in any form of malpractice in the examination are liable to severe penalty.
- Students shall not be permitted into the examination hall after 30 minutes from the time of commencement of examination.
- Students should not write their names or any other identification marking except their Register Number on the answer scripts.
- No student shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of at least half an hour of the issue of question paper.
- No paper other than the question paper shall be taken out of the examination hall.
